Mental Health Awareness Training Saturday 30 October 2021 from 10 am to 2 pm The Rectory Chulmleigh.



The course is provided by Mind <https://www.mind.org.uk> and will be presented by Richard Wakerell, Training Manager, Devon Mind. Richard is also a minister in the Church of England serving in the Plympton Mission Community.

All of our churches will at some time come into contact with people who are experiencing mental ill-health. People who are suffering from mental health conditions often experience fear, loneliness, isolation, deep emotional pain and stigma whilst struggling to access mental health services. Our churches, which welcome all people, are places that people with mental health conditions may seek out, for the welcome, compassion, safety and peace that being in God's presence can provide. As disciples of Jesus we are called to love one another and especially those who are suffering. We can be part of Jesus healing process, caring for those who are experiencing mental health challenges and promoting mental well-being. This course will provide, through video, case studies, small group work and discussion an understanding of the more common types of mental illness, the effects of medication, treatment and recovery and good practice when working with people with mental health conditions.

Mark 10.17-31

17 As he was setting out on a journey, a man ran up and knelt before him, and asked him, 'Good Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?' 18 Jesus said to him, 'Why do you call me good? No one is good but God alone. 19 You know the commandments: "You shall not murder; You shall not commit adultery; You shall not steal; You shall not bear false witness; You shall not defraud; Honour your father and mother." 20 He said to him, 'Teacher, I have kept all these since my youth.' 21 Jesus, looking at him, loved him and said, 'You lack one thing;

go, sell what you own, and give the money to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; then come, follow me.' 22 When he heard this, he was shocked and went away grieving, for he had many possessions. 23 Then Jesus looked around and said to his disciples, 'How hard it will be for those who have wealth to enter the kingdom of God!' 24 And the disciples were perplexed at these words. But Jesus said to them again, 'Children, how hard it is to enter the kingdom of God! 25 It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for someone who is rich to enter the kingdom of God.' 26 They were greatly astounded and said to one another, 'Then who can be saved?' 27 Jesus looked at them and said, 'For mortals it is impossible, but not for God; for God all things are possible.'

28 Peter began to say to him, 'Look, we have left everything and followed you.' 29 Jesus said, 'Truly I tell you, there is no one who has left house or brothers or sisters or mother or father or children or fields, for my sake and for the sake of the good news, 30 who will not receive a hundredfold now in this age—houses, brothers and sisters, mothers and children, and fields, with persecutions—and in the age to come eternal life. 31 But many who are first will be last, and the last will be first.'
