Reopening of our churches

In response to the government permission to re-open places of worship we have been working to re-open those churches where we have the people to undertake the necessary work and the required agreement between the PCC and the incumbent.

As of this weekend three of our churches will have re-opened for private prayer including Chawleigh and Meshaw. So thank you to all of those who have worked hard to clean, clear, and sign post our churches to make this possible.

Although preparations have been made in Chulmleigh we do not currently have the full agreement of the PCC to re-open and as a result we will not be opening the church until we undertake a further review at the end of August 2020.

Elsewhere in the Mission Community three of our churches, are looking to prepare to re-open for services including Eggesford, Thelbridge and Witheridge either later in July or in August 2020.

It is wonderful that several of our churches are working to re-open and we look forward to doing so. However we need to ensure that we do so safely.

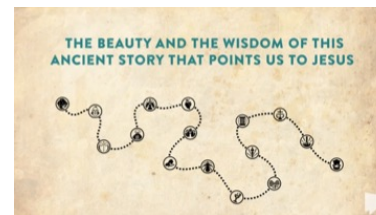
