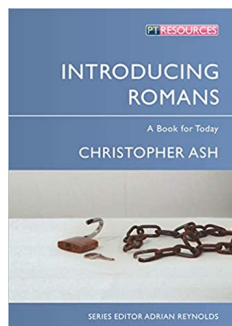

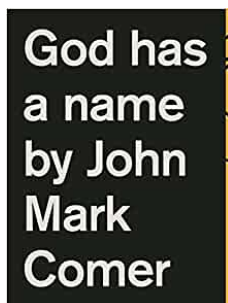
Romans

God has a name



St Mary Magdalene Church in Chulmleigh starts on a new shared teaching series looking at the book "God has a name" by John Mark Comer this Sunday. This builds strongly upon our time in the Old Testament with an accessible look at who God is through God's own description of himself to Moses found in Exodus 34: 4-7. In places we will look at the scriptures word by word but with a wonderful depth that John Mark Comer relates

to everyday life, including when God says something twice that we should stop and listen.

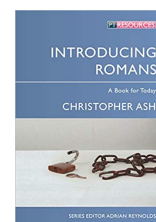
