Reopening of our churches

In response to the government permission to re-open places of worship we have been working to re-open those churches where we have the people to undertake the necessary work and the required agreement between the PCC and the incumbent.

Currently four of our churches will have re-opened for private prayer including Chawleigh, Meshaw and Witheridge.

St James, Chawleigh is open for private prayer

Monday morning 10 am to 11 am and

Thursday afternoon from 3 pm to 4 pm.

St John the Baptist, Meshaw is open for private prayer

Sunday morning 9 am- 1 pm and

Wednesday afternoon from 2 – 6 pm.

St John the Baptist, Witheridge is open for private prayer

Sunday morning 10 am - 12 pm with organ music

from 11 am -12 pm when possible and

Wednesday afternoon 2 - 4 pm.

Elsewhere in the Mission Community three of our churches, are ready to hold services including Eggesford and Thelbridge in late July and Witheridge in August 2020, see details overleaf, with preparations are underway in East Worlington and discussions starting in Cheldon.

Witheridge hopes to offer a Holy Communion service every Sunday morning at 9.30 am starting on Sunday 2nd of August, and you are very warmly welcomed to attend. This will be very restricted with numbers with a total of 14 household slots each Sunday - individual, couple or family. To control the numbers and not have to turn anyone away from the service it will be necessary to operate a ticket system. Please contact Adrian on 01884 861383 to request a space or email vicaradrian@gmail.com Areas of Witheridge church have been closed off to ensure social distancing, we ask you to respect the closures. Witheridge has no toilet or hand washing facilities available however there is a plentiful supply of 70% alcohol gel.

Although preparations have been made in Chulmleigh we do not currently have the full agreement of the PCC to re-open and as a result we will not be opening the church until we undertake a further review at the end of August 2020.

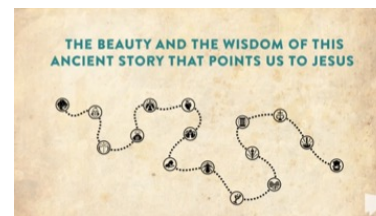
