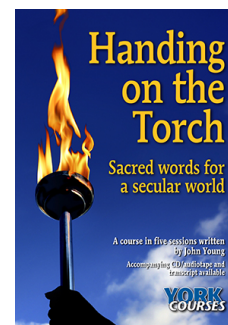

### Handing on the torch' sacred words for a secular world – York Course

Christianity is the largest movement our world has ever seen. It continues to grow at an immense pace – especially in Asia (including China), Africa and Latin America. At the same time, Christianity in the West struggles to grow and – perhaps – even to survive.

In this course we consider some of the reasons for this and what it might mean for individual Christians, for churches and for Western culture, in a world where alternative beliefs are increasingly on offer.

The course will run over five sessions : from 7pm to 9pm on Wednesday evenings.

### God has a name



St Mary Magdalene Church in Chulmleigh continues with a teaching series looking at the book "God has a name" by John Mark. This builds strongly upon our time in the Old Testament with an accessible look at who God is through God's own description of himself to Moses found in Exodus 34: 4-7. In places we will look at the

scriptures word by word but with a wonderful depth that John Mark Comer relates to everyday life, including when God says something twice that we should stop and listen. The teaching series will be in 8 parts:
